

Crash TrendJune to August




The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which has multiple members selected.

From June 1st to August 31st, WPD responded to an average of 92 accidents per month. This is a 5.7% increase from May to July's average.

WPD officers conducted 71 more traffic stops in August than in the month of July, with a total of 271 stops.






There were 103 total vehicle crashes in the month of August, which is 7 more than July. 43 accident reports were completed in TREDS.

The highest crash hour in August was 12 pm.


Sector 4 remains the sector with the highest number of crashes for three months in a row, with 34 for the month of August. The second highest was Sector 3, then 1, 2, and 5.

Traffic Enforcement Outcomes




In the month of August, there were 271 total traffic stops, resulting in 144 Citations, 107 Warnings, 19 with No Enforcement, and 1 Arrest. There were also 5 DUI Arrests made.


Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Failure to Have Vehicle Inspected, Expired Registration, Failure to Obey Highway Sign/Marking, Operating Veh w/ Exp Rejection, Driving w/out Lights, and Speeding 15-19 Over.

Top Reasons for Traffic Stops






Winchester Police Department August Distracted Driving Point Map


In August, there were 7 Citations and 2 Warnings written for distracted driving, making a total of 9.
