Crash Trend

May to July



The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which has multiple members selected.

From May 1st to July 31st, WPD responded to an average of 87 accidents per month. This is a 4.8% increase from April to June's average.

WPD officers conducted 74 fewer traffic stops in July than in the month of June, with a total of 200 stops.






There were 96 total vehicle crashes in the month of July, which is 20 more than June. 35 accident reports were completed in TREDS.

The highest crash hour in July was 4 pm.


Sector 4 remains the sector with the highest number of crashes for two months in a row, with 34 for the month of July. The second highest was Sector 3, then 1, and 2.

Winchester Police Department July Vehicle Crash Heat Map








In the month of July, there were 200 total traffic stops, resulting in 93 Citations, 92 Warnings, 11 with No Enforcement, and 4 Arrests. There were also 7 DUI Arrests made.


Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Expired Registration, Failure to Have Vehicle Inspected, Speeding 15-19 and 1-9 Over, Failure to Obey Traffic Signal, Stop/Yield, and Lane Marking.

Top Reasons for Traffic Stops






Winchester Police Department July Distracted Driving Point Map

Distracted Driving by Code






In July, there was 1 Citation and 1 Warning written for distracted driving, making a total of 2.
