Crash Trend

March to May




The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which keeps March 2025, April 2025 and May 2025.

From March 1st to May 31st, WPD responded to an average of 90 accidents per month. This is a 9.75% increase from February to April's average.

WPD officers conducted 33 fewer traffic stops in May compared to the month of April.






There were 89 total vehicle crashes in the month of May, which is 4 more than April, but still a decrease from March (97 crashes). 29 accident reports were completed in TREDS, leaving 60 crashes non-reportable.

The highest crash hour in May was 2 pm.

Sector 3 had the highest number of crashes again for the second month in a row, at 30 for the month. The second highest was Sector 4, then 2, 1, and 5 (DTM).


Crashes by Sector

Traffic Stop Count Total DUIs






In the month of May, there were 237 total traffic stops, resulting in 98 Citations, 104 Warnings, 25 with No Enforcement, and 10 Arrests. There were also 10 DUI Arrests made.


Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Failure to Have Vehicle Inspected, Expired Registration, , Failure to Obey Traffic Signals, Lane Markings, Driving without a License, and Driving without Lights.

Top Reasons for Traffic Stops





Winchester Police Department May Traffic Enforcement Heat Map



Distracted Driving by Code




In May, there were 10 Citations and 2 Warnings written for distracted driving, making a total of 12.
