#### Crash Trend

#### August to October



The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which keeps August 2025, September 2025 and October 2025.

From August 1st to October 31st, WPD responded to an average of 101 accidents per month. This is a 3.8% decrease from July to September's average. We saw a significant drop in traffic crashes in the month of October, with a total of 83.

WPD officers conducted 137 more traffic stops in October than in the month of September.






There were 83 total vehicle crashes in the month of October, which is 33 less than September and 20 less than August. 32 accident reports were completed in TREDS.

The highest crash hour in October was 3 pm.


Sector 3 surpassed sector 4 for the sector with the highest number of crashes, with 35 for the month of October, ending sector 4's four month streak. The second highest was Sector 4, then 2, 1, and 5.






In the month of October, there were 355 total traffic stops, resulting in 184 Citations, 133 Warnings, 32 with No Enforcement, and 6 Arrests. There were also 4 DUI Arrests made.


Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Expired Registration, Failure to Have Vehicle Inspected, Failure to Stop/Yield, Failure to Obey Sign/Marking, Failure to Obey Highway Traffic Signal, Drive w/ out License, Drive w/ out Lights, Speeding 10-14 Over, and Speeding 15-19 Over.

#### Top Reasons for Traffic Stops






### Winchester Police Department October Distracted Driving Point Map




In October, there were 10 Citations written for distracted driving, and 2 Warnings, making a total of
