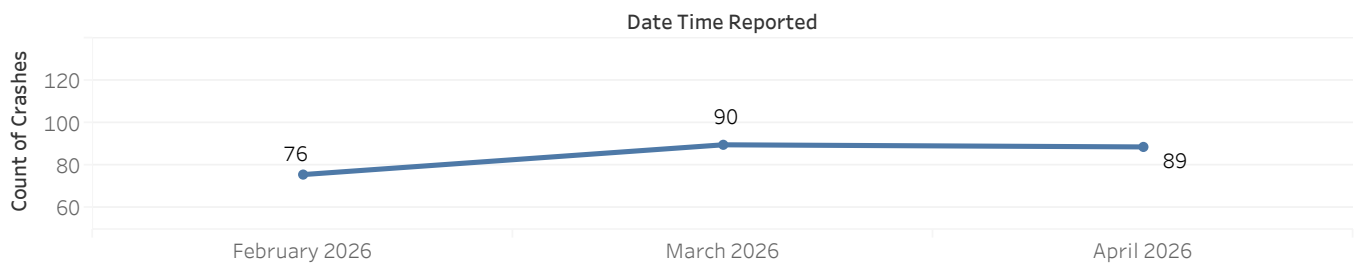

Crash Trend

February to April



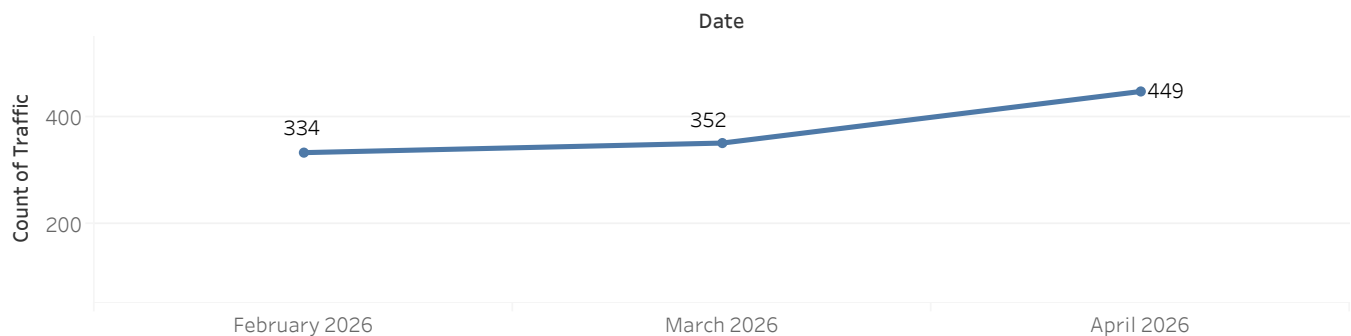
The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which has multiple members selected.

From February 1st to April 30th, WPD responded to an average of 85 accidents per month. This is a 6.25% increase from January to March's average.

WPD officers conducted nearly 100 more traffic stops in April than in the month of March.

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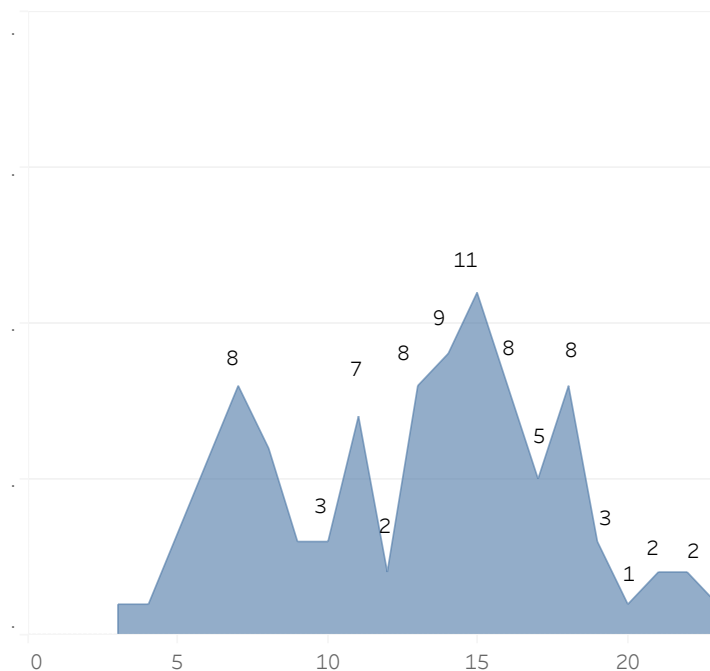
April Vehicle Crash Analysis

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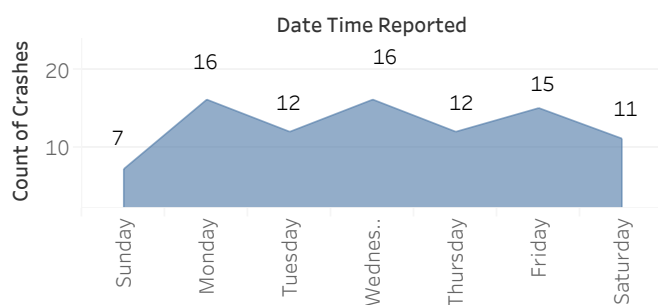
Crash Count

Crashes by Day of Week



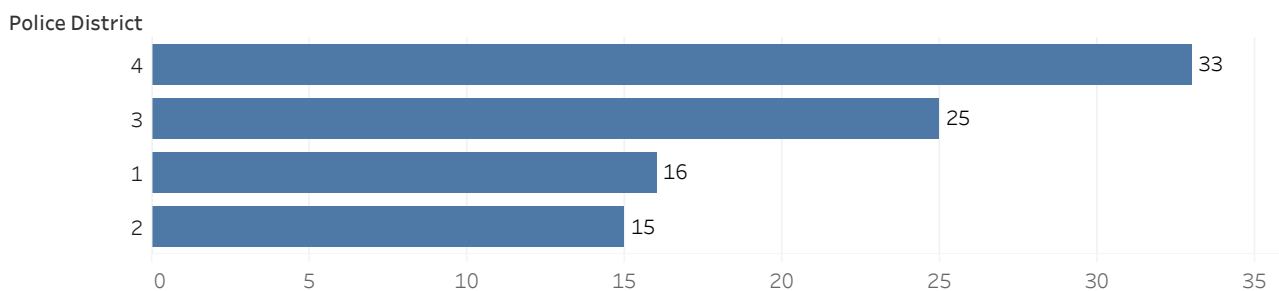
There were 89 total vehicle crashes in the month of April, which is 1 less than March's total. 34 accident reports were completed in TREDs.

The top crash day in April was tied between Monday and Wednesday, with 16 crashes each, followed by Friday, which had 15 total.

The highest crash hour in April was 3 pm, followed by 2 pm. Crashes were heaviest in the afternoon between 1-6 pm, but had a few spikes in the morning hours as well.

Sector 4 had the highest number of crashes, with 33 total, followed by Sector 3 with 25. Sector 1 had 16 and Sector 2 had 15.

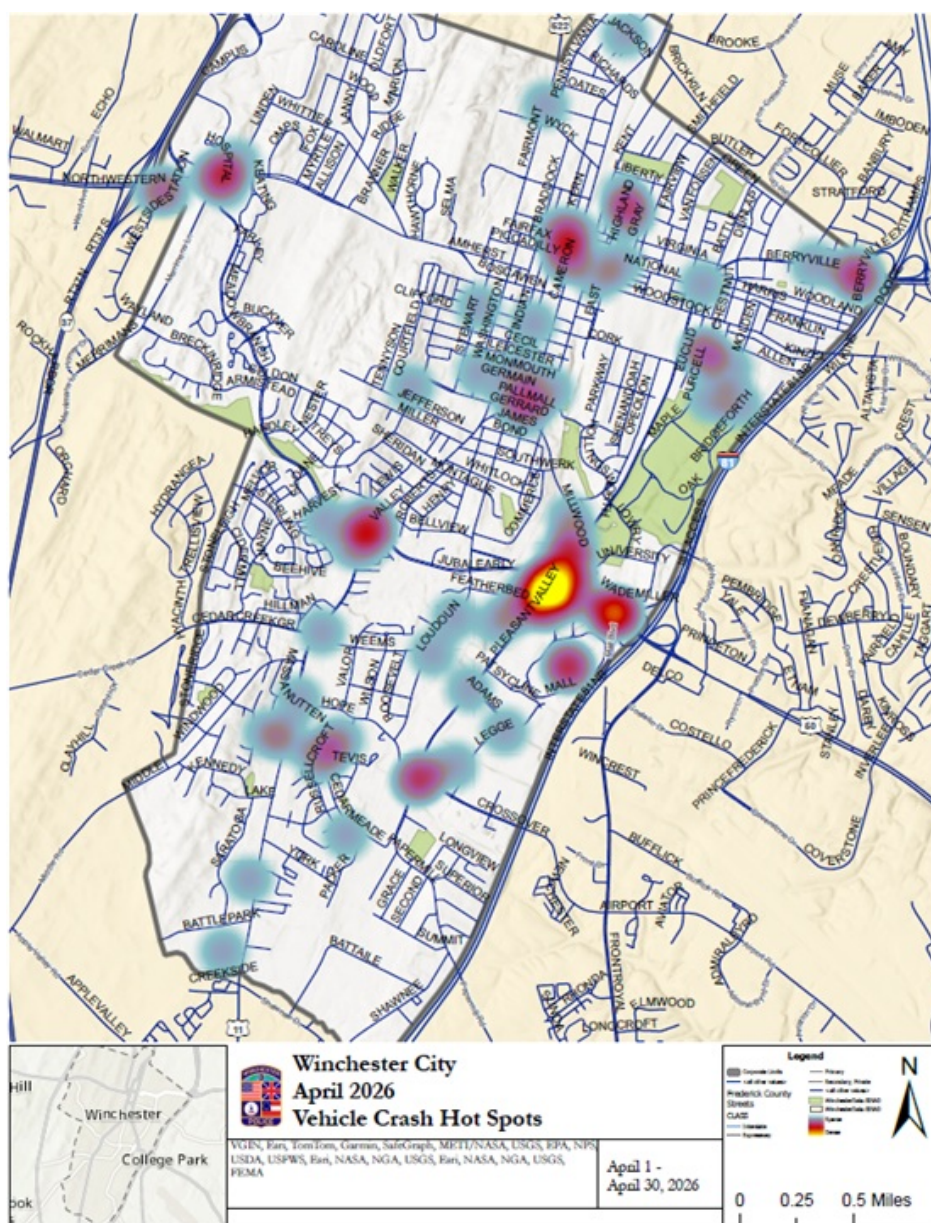
Crashes by Sector

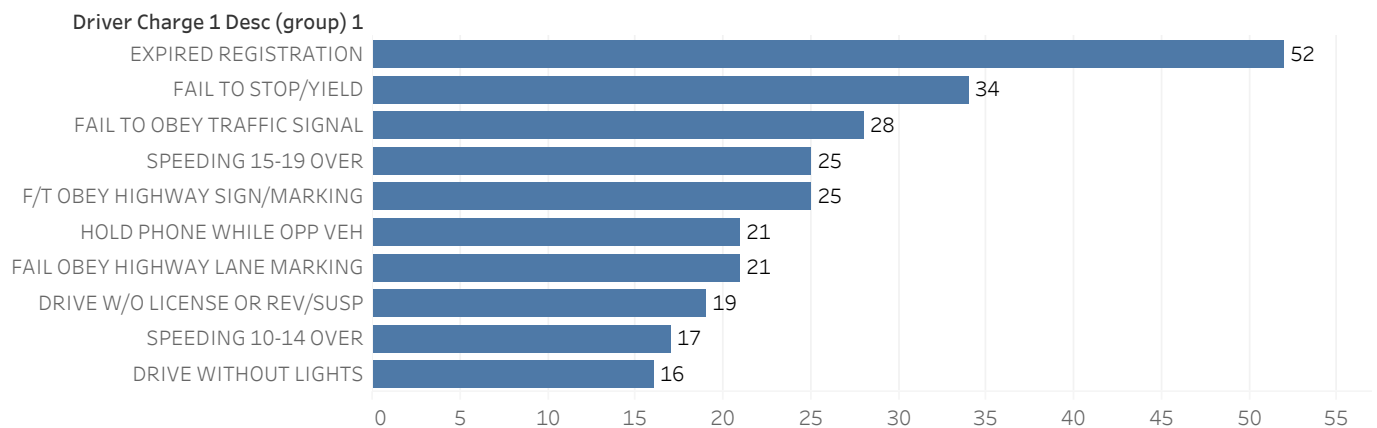

In the month of April, there were 449 total traffic stops, resulting in 201 Citations, 217 Warnings, 27 with No Enforcement, and 4 Arrests. There were also 9 DUI Arrests made.

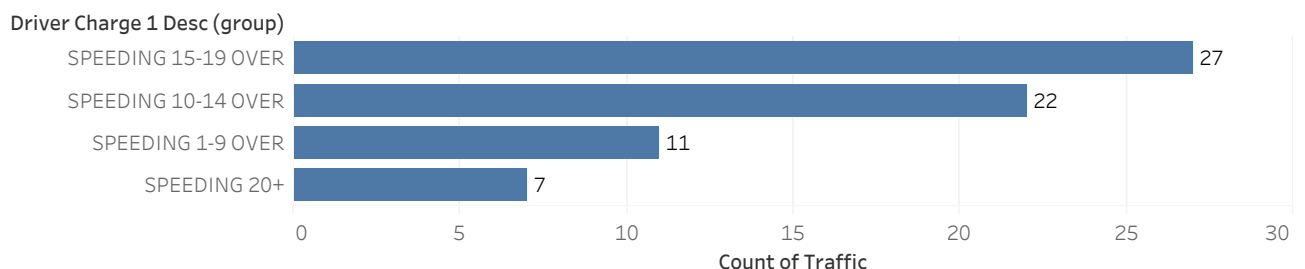
Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Expired Registration, F/T Stop/Yield, Fail to Obey Traffic Signal, Speeding 15-19 Over, F/T Obey Highway Sign/Marking, Hold Phone While Opp Veh, F/T Obey Lane Marking, Drive w/ out License, Speeding 10-14 Over, and Drive w/ out Lights.

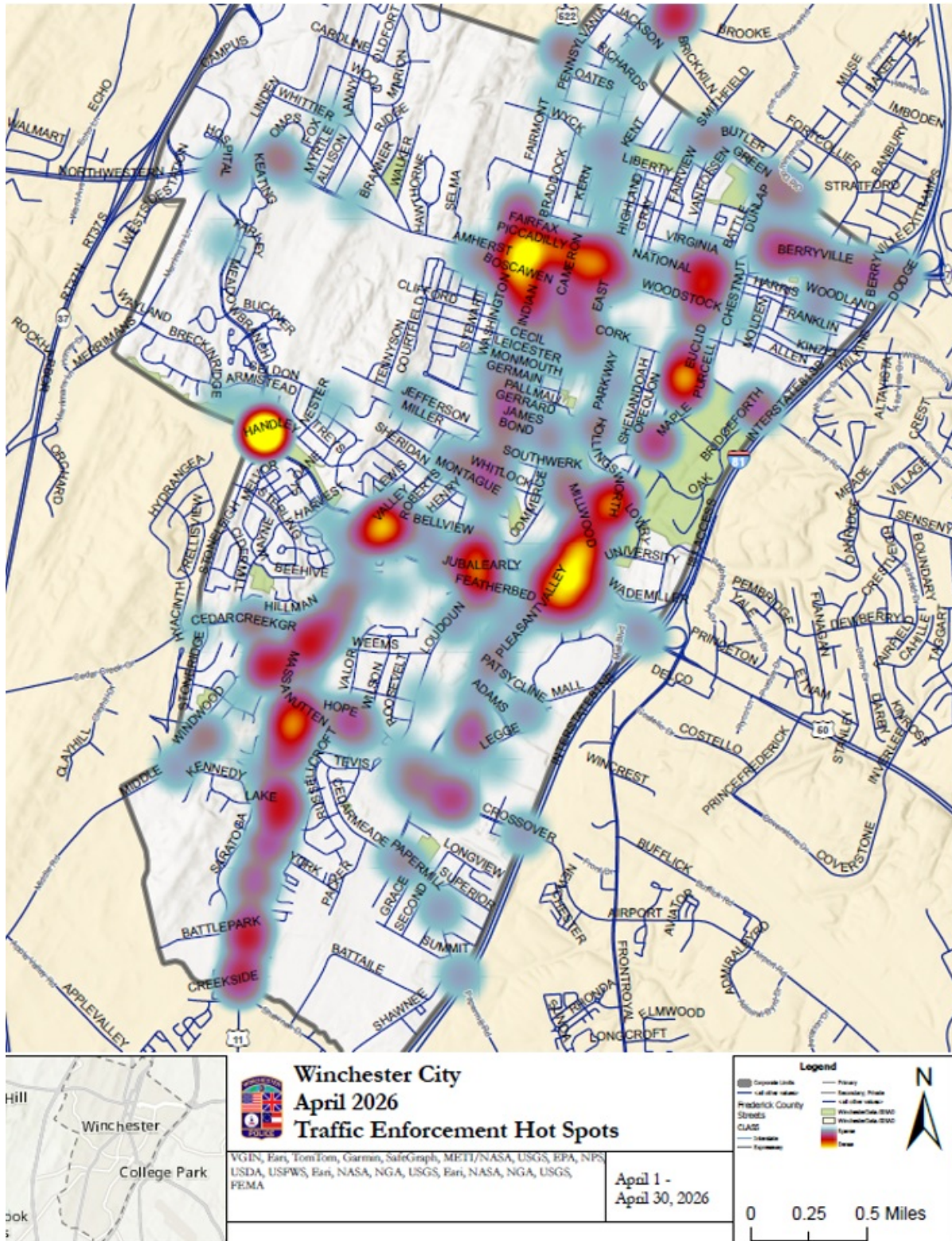

Winchester Police Department April Traffic Enforcement Heat Map

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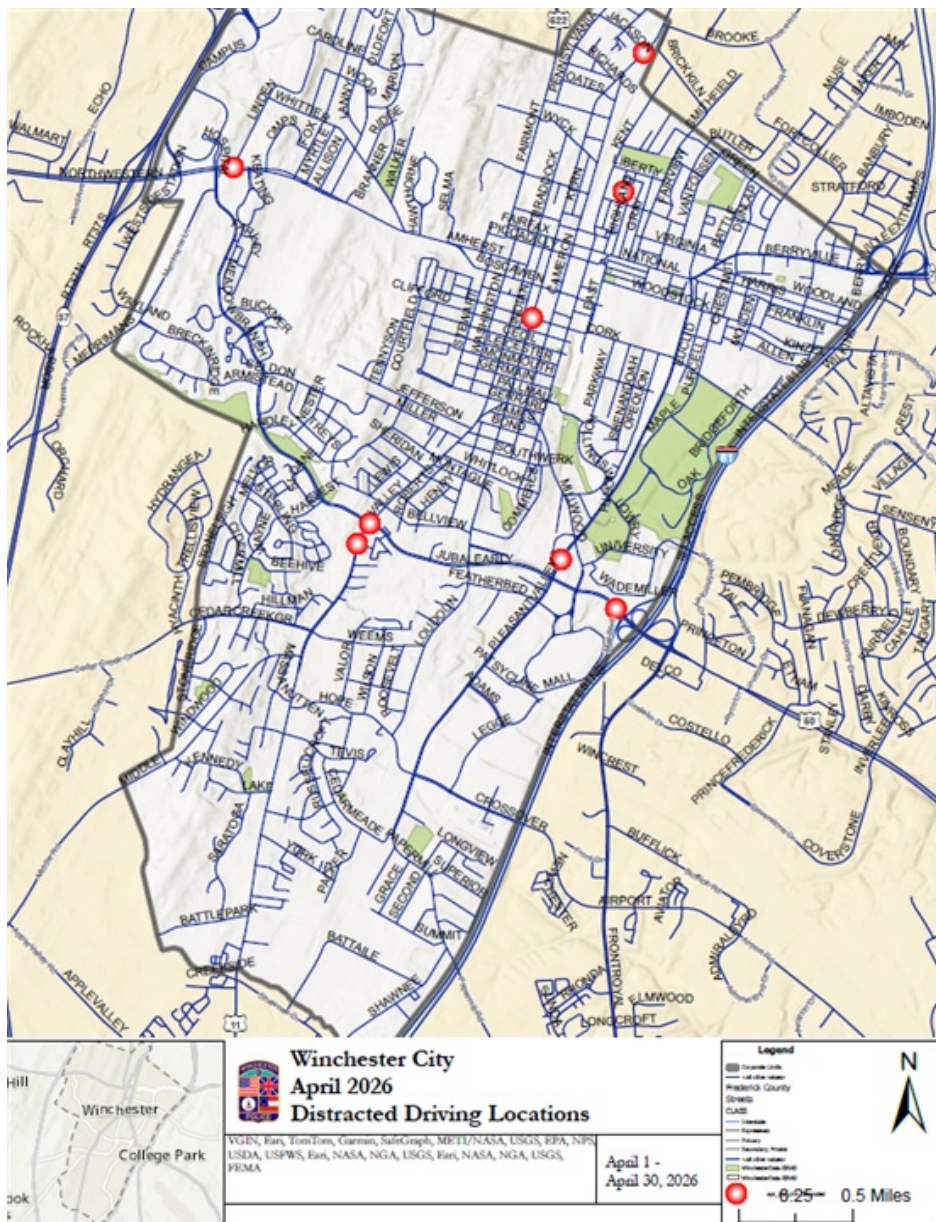


Winchester Police Department April Distracted Driving Point Map

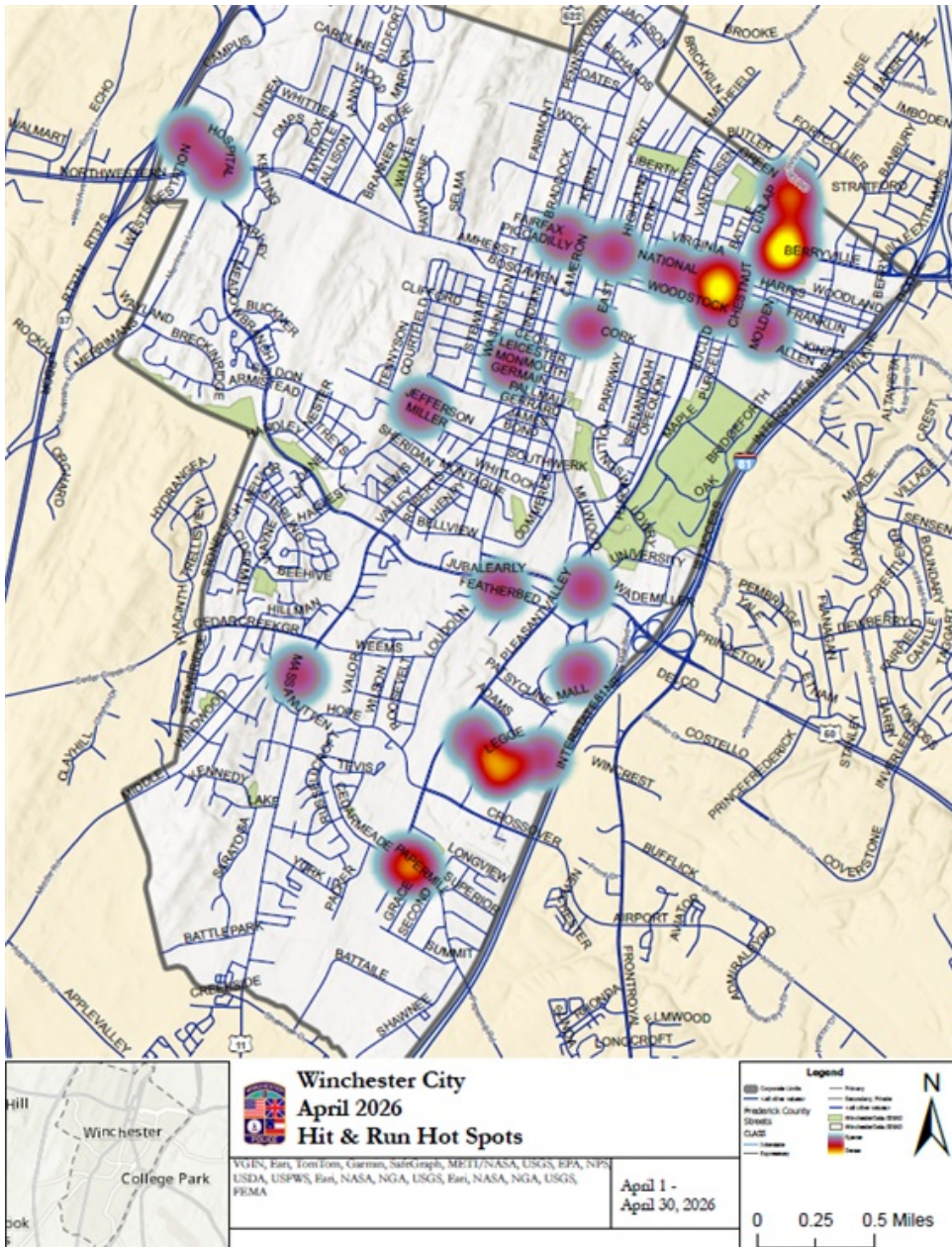


In April, there were 9 Citations written for distracted driving, and 0 Warnings.
