

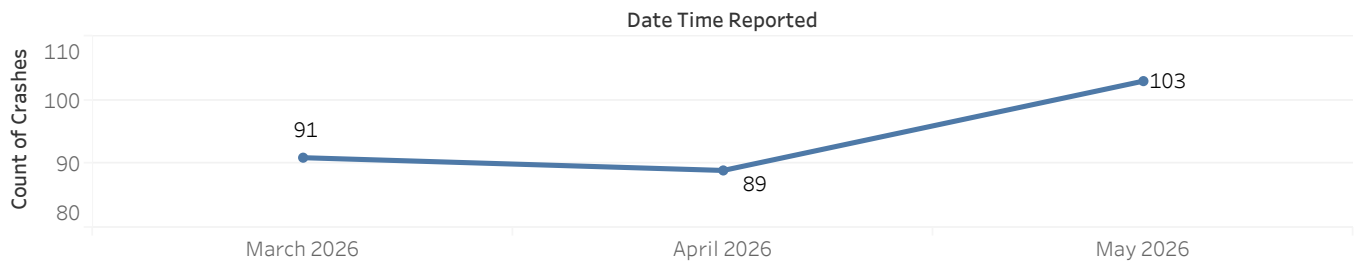

Crash Trend March to May

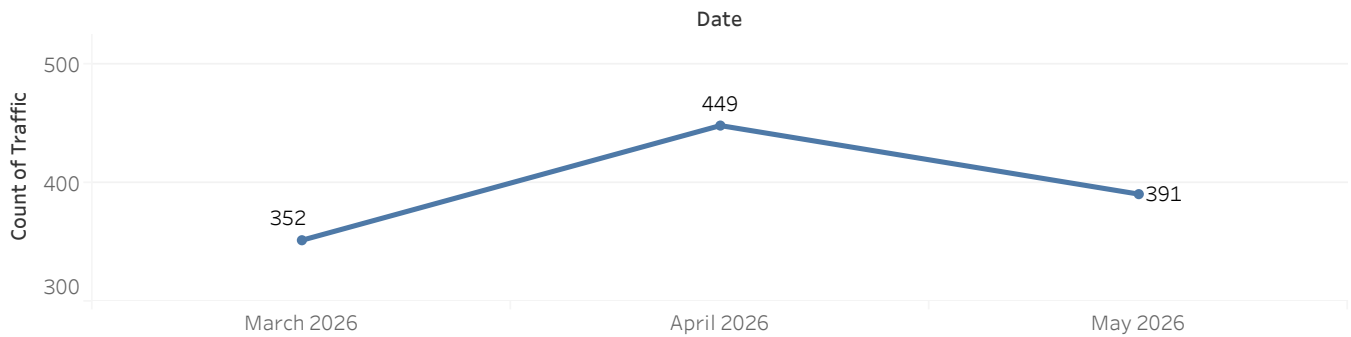


The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which has multiple members selected.

From March 1st to May 31st, WPD responded to an average of 94 accidents per month. This is a 10.6% increase from February to April's average.

WPD officers conducted 58 fewer traffic stops in May than in the month of April.

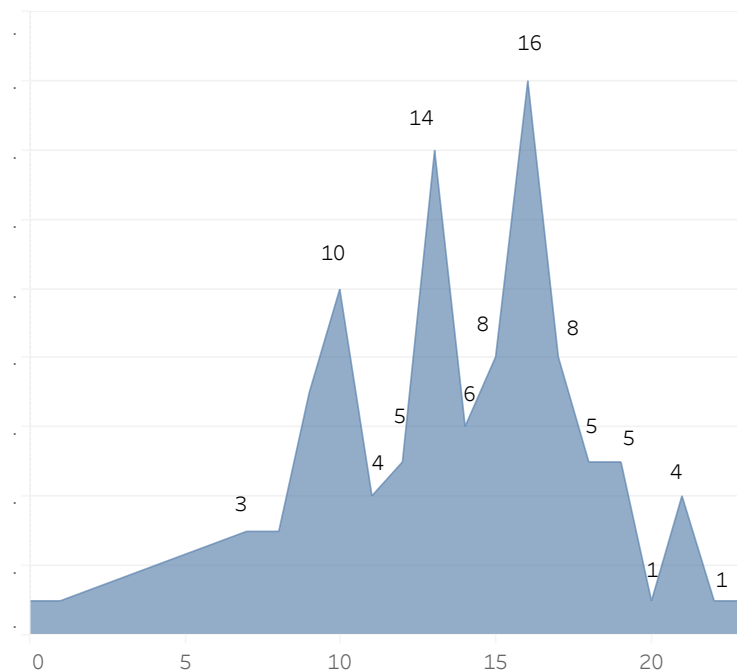

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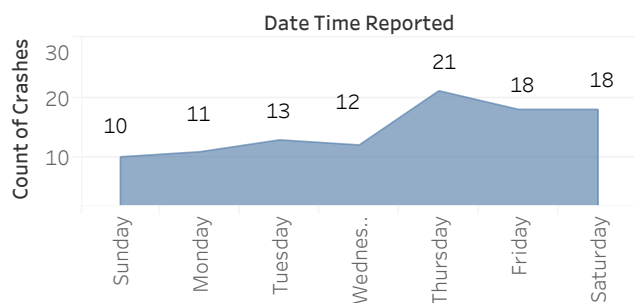
Crash Count

Crashes by Day of Week



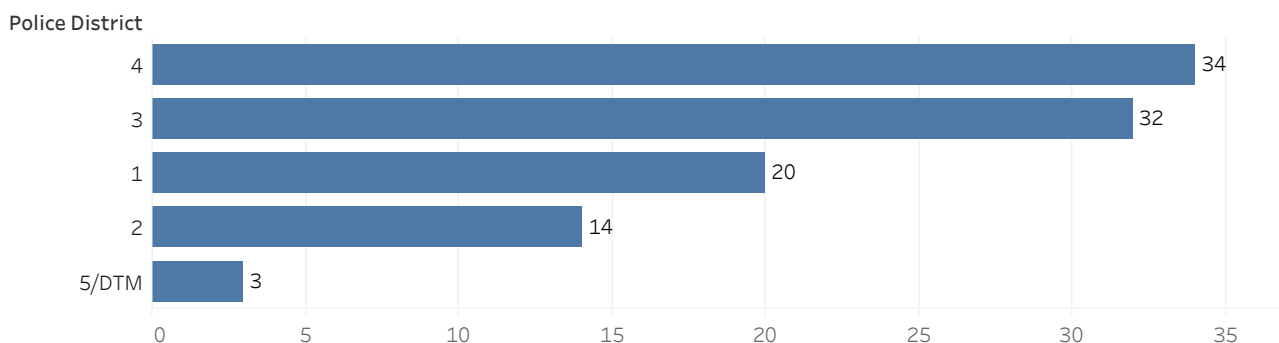
There were 103 total vehicle crashes in the month of May, which is 14 more than April's total. 39 accident reports were completed in TREDs.

The top crash day in May was Thursday, with 21 total crashes, followed by Friday and Saturday, which had 18 each.

The highest crash hour in May was 4 pm, followed by 1 pm.

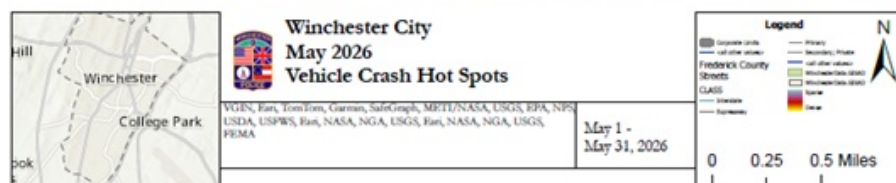
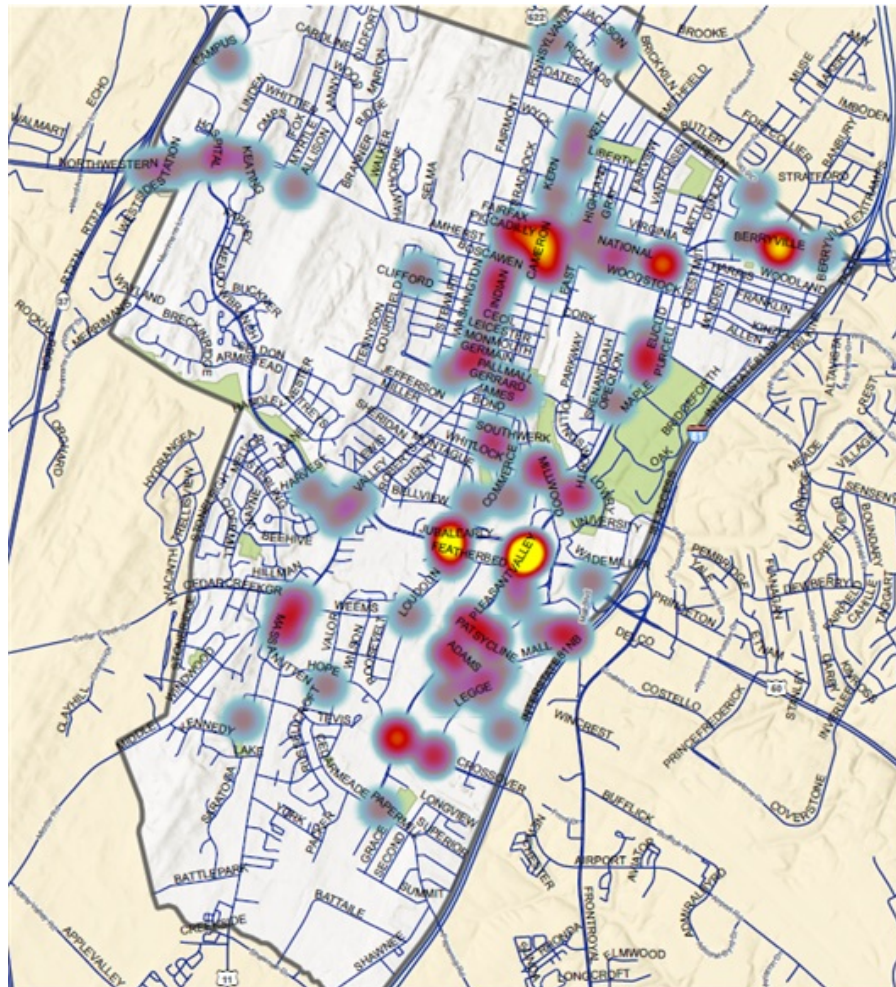
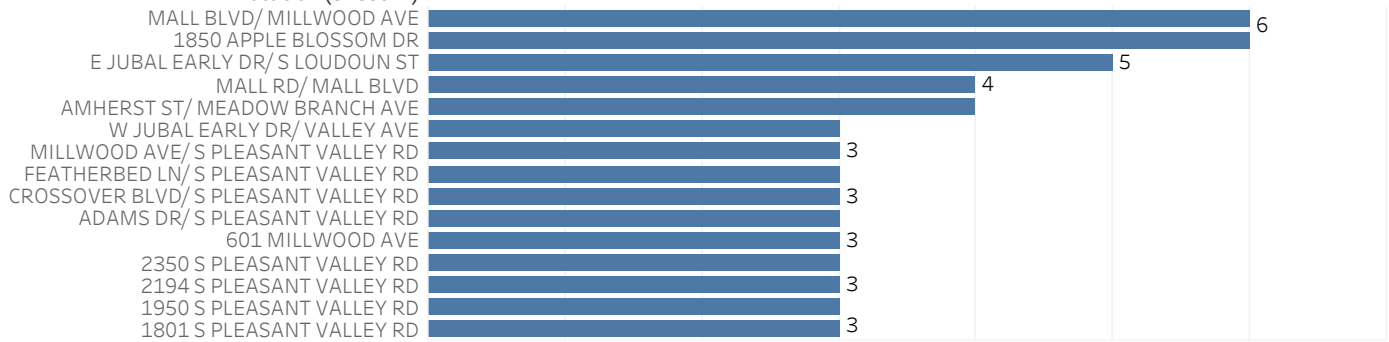
Sector 4 had the highest number of crashes, with 34 total, followed by Sector 3 with 32. Sector 1 had 20, Sector 2 had 14, and the DTM had 3.

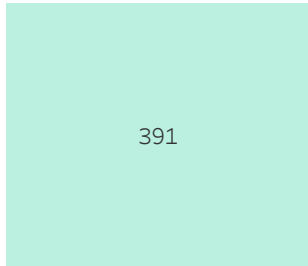

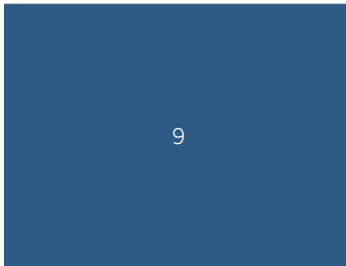

Traffic Enforcement Outcomes

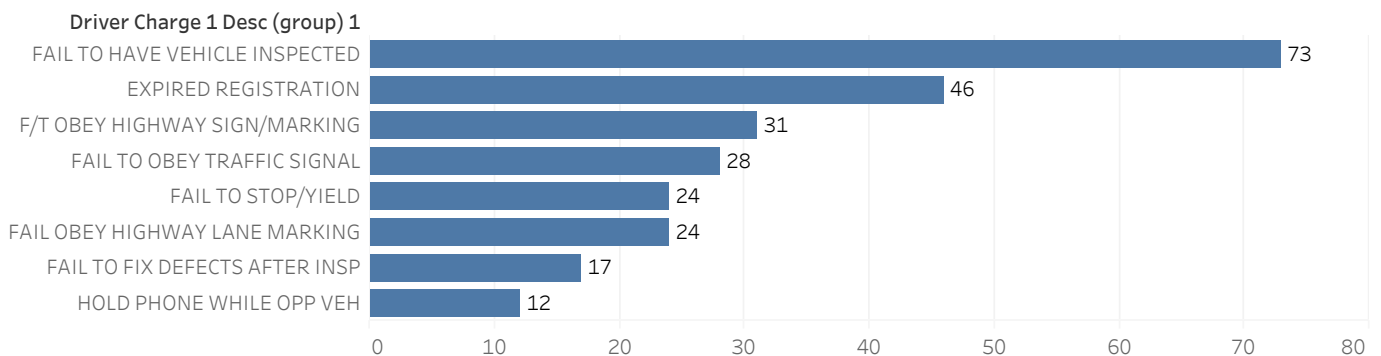

In the month of May, there were 391 total traffic stops, resulting in 188 Citations, 158 Warnings, 39 with No Enforcement, and 6 Arrests. There were also 9 DUI Arrests made.

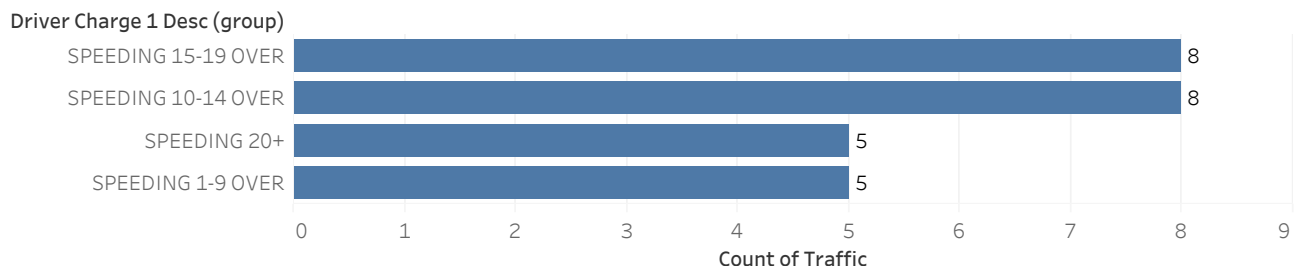
Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Fail to Have Vehicle Inspected, Expired Registration, F/T Obey Highway Sign/Marking/Traffic Signal/Stop/Yield/Lane Marking, Fail to Fix Defects after Inspection, and Hold Phone While Opp Vehicle.

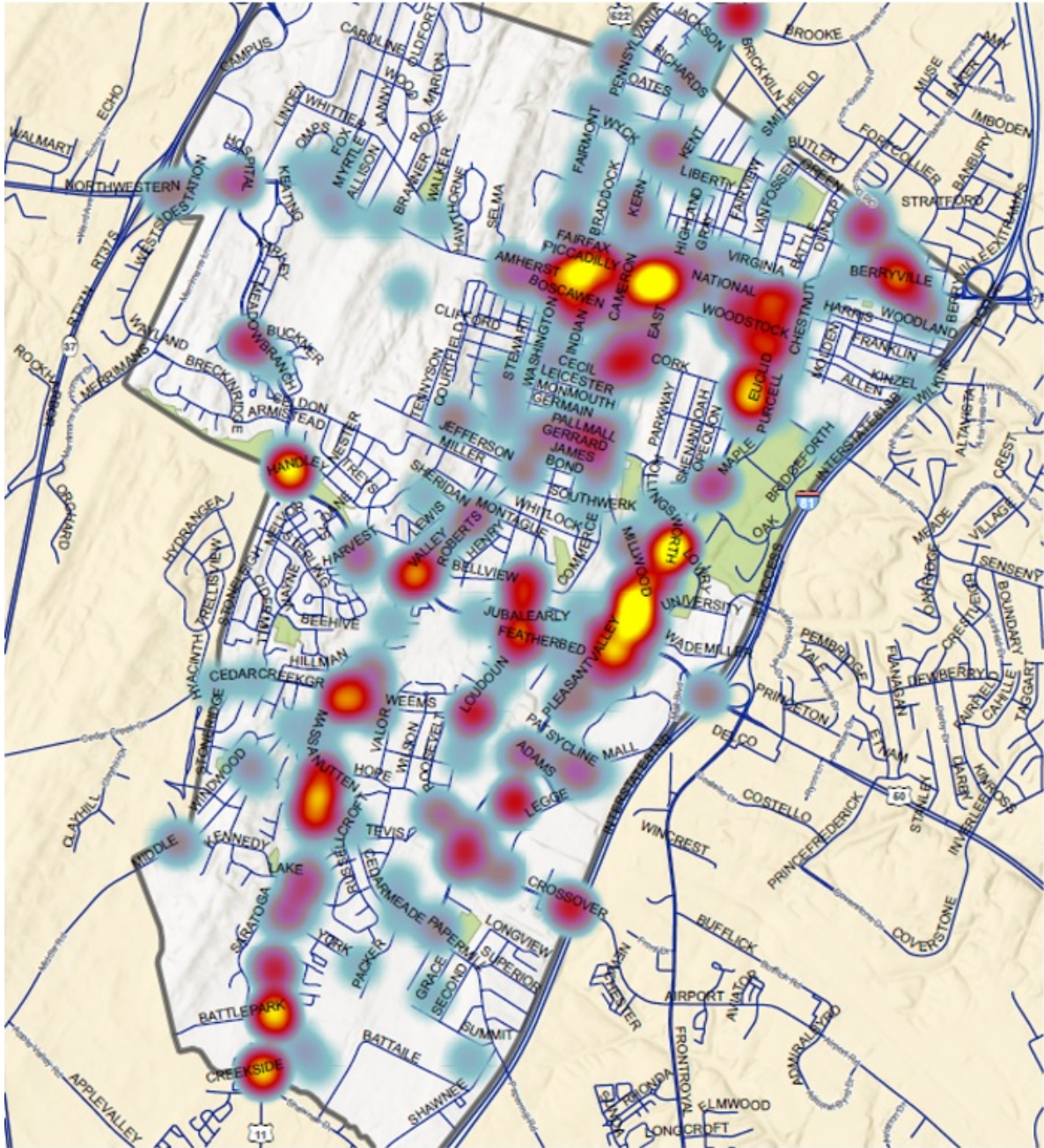

Winchester Police Department May Traffic Enforcement Heat Map

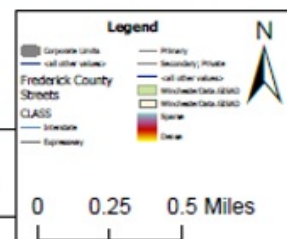
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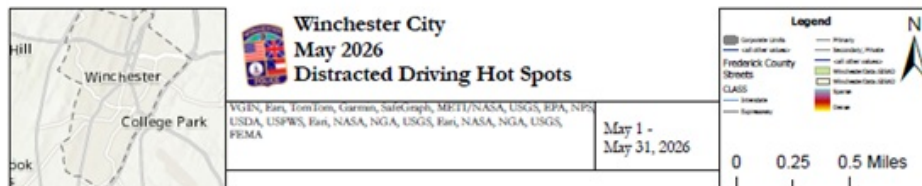

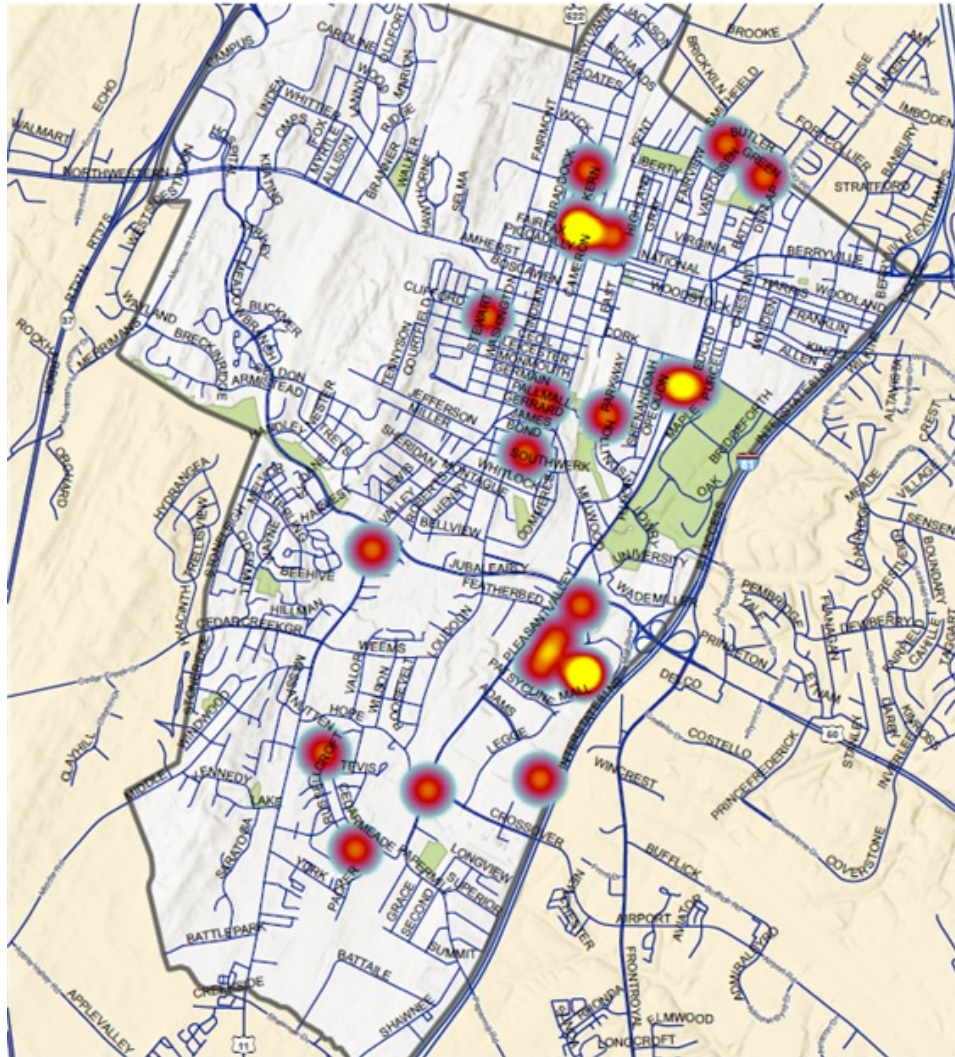

There were a total of 22 Hit & Runs in the month of May, which is 4 less than last month.

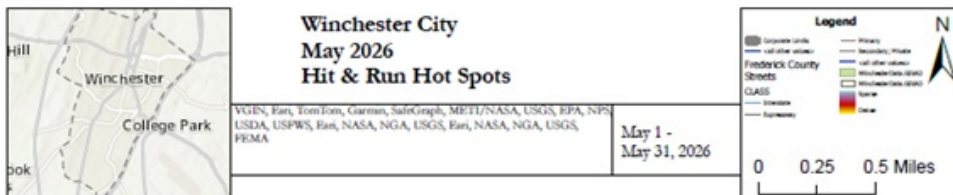
5 cases are inactive, 1 resulted in an arrest, and 16 of them remain active.
