



Crash Trend

June to August




The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which keeps June 2024, July 2024 and August 2024.

From June 1st to August 31st, WPD responded to an average of 90 accidents per month. This average remains a 3% increase from April to June's average.

WPD officers conducted 120 fewer traffic stops in August compared to the month of July, but still increased the total traffic enforcement 30% from June.






There were 98 total vehicle crashes in the month of August, which is 1 less crash than last month. There were 58 Accident Reports completed. 40 accidents were non-reportable.

The highest crash hour in August was 2 pm.

Sector 4 had the highest number of crashes at 35 for the month, followed by Sector 3, then 2, and 1.




In the month of August, there were 360 total traffic stops, resulting in 136 Citations, 178 Warnings, 23 with No Enforcement, and 23 Arrests. There were also 26 DUI Arrests made.


Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Failure to Obey Lane Marking, Expired Registration, Failure to Have Vehicle Inspected, Driving w/o License, and Holding Phone while Operating Vehicle.

Top Reasons for Traffic Stops





Winchester Police Department August Traffic Enforcement Heat Map



Distracted Driving by Code




In August, there were 12 Citations and 1 Warning written for distracted driving, making a total of 13.
