

### Crash Trend




The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which keeps November 2024, December 2024 and January 2025.

From November 1st to January 31st, WPD responded to an average of 92 accidents per month. This is an 8% decrease from October to December's average.

WPD officers conducted 33 fewer traffic stops in January compared to the month of December.



# Winchester Police Department January Vehicle Crash Analysis



There were 84 total vehicle crashes in the month of January, which is a 16% decrease from December. There were 27 Accident Reports completed. 57 accidents were non-reportable.

The highest crash hour in January remained 2 pm.

Sector 4 had the highest number of crashes at 36 for the month, followed by Sector 3, then 2, and 1.




In the month of January, there were 329 total traffic stops, resulting in 135 Citations, 171 Warnings, 20 with No Enforcement, and 3 Arrests. There were also 4 DUI Arrests made.


Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were Expired Registration, Speeding 15-19 Over, Failure to have Vehicle Inspected, Driving without Lights, and Failure to Obey Highway Signs and Lane Markings.

### Top Reasons for Traffic Stops







Citations and 2 Warning written for distracted driving, making a total of 7.


