The trend of count of Crashes for Date Time Reported (MY). The view is filtered on Date Time Reported (MY), which has multiple members selected.

From April 1st to June 30th, WPD responded to an average of 87 accidents per month. This is a 3% decrease from March to May's average.

Traffic enforcement efforts have been nearly cut in half since April, with officers conducting 275 total traffic stops in June versus 546 in April.

The trend of count of Traffic for Date (MY). The view is filtered on Date (MY), which has multiple members selected.



Winchester Police Department June Vehicle Crash Analysis



There were 75 total vehicle crashes in the month of May, which is 23 fewer crashes than last month. There were 49 Accident Reports completed. 26 accidents were non-reportable.

The highest crash hour in June remains 4pm.

Sector 4 had the highest number of crashes at 31 for the month, followed by Sector 3, then 1, and 2.




In the month of May, there were 275 total traffic stops, resulting in 104 Citations, 141 Warnings, 23 with No Enforcement, and 7 Arrests. There were also 12 DUI Arrests made.


Note: DUI Arrests are not always a result of a Traffic Stop and are sometimes a result of a Traffic Crash.

The top reasons for Traffic Stops were No Inspection, Expired Registration, Failure to Obery Highway Sign/Marking, Driving without Lights/with Excessive Lights, Driving without a License/Suspended/Revoked, and Speeding.

Top Reasons for Traffic Stops



Winchester Police Department June Vehicle Crash Heat Map





In June, there were 7 Citations and 4 Warnings written for distracted driving, making a total of 11.


All 11 were under the State Charge Section Code 46.2-818.2.
